First Aid Kit

- In a gallon ziploc bag place:
 - o 5 Bandaids
 - 5 Cough Drops
 - 1 Neosporin (can be single use or small tube)
 - 5 Alcohol swabs
 - o 5 Q-tips
 - 1 Small kleenex pack
 - o Optional: note of encouragement

Warming Kit

- In a gallon ziploc bag place:
 - o 1 Pair of socks
 - 1 Set of HotHands hand warmers
 - 1 Soft/chewy granola bar
 - 5 Cough drops
 - o 1 Chapstick
 - o 1 Small pack of Kleenex
 - Optional: note of encouragement

Snack Pack

- In a gallon ziploc bag place:
 - Bottle of water
 - Soft/chewy granola bar OR cheese and crackers package
 - Tuna pack OR vienna sausage
 - Fruit cup
 - Plastic Spoon
 - Optional: note of encouragement

Hygiene Kit

- In quart ziploc bag place:
 - 5 Pads (any absorbency)
 - 5 Tampons (any absorbency)
 - 5 Panty liners
 - Optional: a small pack of wipes and hand sanitizer
